<b>Name</b>	Canadian Foundation for Geotechnique National Graduate Scholarship
<b>Value</b>	The value of the scholarship is: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• \$5,000, for one year, non-renewable.</li> </ul>
<b>Criteria</b>	The following criteria apply: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Canadian citizen or permanent resident</li> <li>• registered at a Canadian University</li> <li>• either entering, or in, a Masters or PhD program</li> <li>• registered in a department and program directly related to an identified field of geotechnique within geotechnical engineering, geological engineering, mining engineering, geoenvironmental engineering or geoscience, engineering geology or hydrogeology</li> <li>• high academic standing</li> <li>• shows activities or leadership in the Canadian geotechnical community</li> <li>• preference given to nominees with practical experience</li> <li>• one candidate per department to be nominated, in writing with rationale, by graduate supervisor.</li> </ul>
<b>Mechanism</b>	The mechanism for awarding the scholarship is: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Foundation to publicize scholarship to all Canadian universities by first of March</li> <li>• graduate supervisor to send nomination to CGS Awards Committee Chair by first of June</li> <li>• CGS Awards Committee to select awardee</li> <li>• if no suitable candidate, scholarship does not have to be awarded</li> <li>• award, in the form of a cheque, to be made by the Foundation at CGS annual conference in the fall.</li> </ul>
